**THE ROSE PROCEDURE**

**A. INITIAL PRIVILEGE REQUEST**

The surgeon requesting privileges for the ROSE procedure meet the following qualifications:

1. Must currently be credentialed to perform endoscopic procedures,
2. Must currently be credentialed to perform bariatric procedures
3. Evidence of special training in USGI Endoscopic Operating System to include:
  - didactic training, which includes patient selection, gastric pouch, and stoma reduction, nomenclature and capability of the Endoscopic Operating Systems
  - hands-on training on an inanimate model with instruction on the use of the devices
  - hands-on training with a porcine model with training on flexible surgery fundamentals, placation acquisition, anchoring methods and advanced instrument maneuvering techniques

and

Letter of successful completion of the training as outlined above.

4. A Focused Practitioner Performance Evaluation (FPPE) for the first 5 procedures. The FPPE may include, but not be limited to:
  - retrospective chart review
  - direct observation
  - proctoring

**B. MAINTENANCE OF PRIVILEGES**

In order to maintain the procedure granted, documentation of a minimum of ten (10) cases must be submitted in conjunction with application for reappointment.
